Incident Activity March 19-25

Monday, March 19

Lift assist in the 100 block of Bein Street. Upon arrival found a 65 year-old-female who had fallen and could not get up. TVEMS assumed patient care, and the crew lifted the female back in her wheel chair. Command was then terminated and Squad 11 went available.

Tuesday, March 20

Citizen assist in the 800 block of 10th Street. Upon arrival met with the homeowner, and she stated she needed help with 3 smoke detectors that needed batteries. The crew replaced the batteries in all 3 detectors and tested them, all were in working order. Homeowner also asked us to check her CO detector. A new battery was placed in that as well.

Berthoud Squad 11 responded to the 2000 block of Clayton Place for a 42 year-old-male having chest pains. TVEMS assumed patient care and the crew assisted with loading of the patient for transport.

BFPD was dispatched to the 300 block of 49th Street SW for a sick person. TVEMS assumed patient care and the crew assisted with loading of the patient for transport.

Wednesday, March 21

Berthoud Fire responded to I-25 mm 252 NB for a semi that was leaking fuel. Upon arrival located the leak that was spilling from the saddle tank of the driver's side. The crew was able to stop the leak, Colorado State Patrol stated that the company has its own tow and a new tractor on its way. Colorado State Patrol Haz-mat cleared Engine 1.

BFPD was dispatched to the 8000 block of Cty Line Road for breathing problems. TVEMS assumed patient care and the crew assisted with loading of the patient for transport. Engine 2 cleared scene and went available.

Berthoud Engine 2 covered Loveland Fire station 3 while they worked a structure fire.

Thursday, March 22

Citizen assist for a car seat installation at Station 2. The Firefighter explained to the citizen on how to properly install the new car seat. Then the Firefighter had the Grandmother do the final installation on the car seat.

Berthoud Squad 11 was dispatched to the 20000 block of Weld Cty Road 7 for a medical. TVEMS assumed patient care and the crew assisted with packaging and loading of the patient. Command was then terminated and all units cleared and went available.

Friday, March 23

Berthoud Engine 2 responded to the 900 block of Prairestar Drive for a cut gas line. Upon arrival found an excavator that had ripped through a gas line. E2 deployed a line and waited for Xcel Energy to arrive. Xcel was able to shut down the gas and the crew cleared scene and went available.

Saturday, March 24

BFPD was dispatched to the 900 block of Eagle Pass for traumatic injury. TVEMS assumed patient care and the crew assisted with loading of the patient for transport.

Berthoud Squad 11 responded to the 300 block of E. Michigan for a sick person. TVEMS assumed patient care, the crew assisted with loading of the patient for transport. Squad 11 cleared and went available.
