<p>Building:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Extended, unsupported roof spans ■ Large windows or panes of glass, especially if: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Not composed of safety glass ■ Located near exits or evacuation routes ■ Suspended ceilings and light fixtures ■ Incompatible chemicals stored in close proximity or not stored in a manner to withstand falling and breaking ■ Hazardous materials located in areas that do not have warning signs ■ Paper or other combustibles (e.g., greasy rags) stored near heat source ■ Unsecured heavy or unstable items, including: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Portable room dividers ■ Appliances (e.g., water heaters, space heaters, microwave ovens) ■ Filing cabinets, bookcases, and wall shelves ■ Athletic equipment ■ Vending machines ■ TV monitors 	

- Wall-mounted objects
- Aquariums
- Table lamps
- Hanging plants above seating areas
- Electrical equipment

Grounds:

- Equipment in need of repair
- Rocks or other material that could cause injury
- Fences in need of repair
- Exposed nails, screws, or bolts
- Trees or shrubs that present a fire hazard or wind hazard or provide areas for an intruder to hide
- Streams in close proximity
- Electrical wires
- Gasoline or propane tanks
- Natural gas lines
