**Explanation:** To ensure that all children present have been evacuated, the responsible person for those children must account for them before evacuating the site to ensure no child is left in the building. Time is of the essence, so the accounting process must be quick. Drills will provide practice to prepare everyone to evacuate efficiently in an emergency.

**TRUE.** If your closing notification will occur in the morning, you should determine the best time based on when the first child is dropped off in the morning.

**Explanation:** If you need to notify parents of site closure in the morning, determine the best time based on the earliest drop-off time.

**FALSE.** When sheltering-in-place for a tornado, you must seal the room by taping windows and doors.

**Explanation:** When sheltering for a tornado, the location selected should be in a basement or an interior room on the lowest level away from corners, windows, doors, and outside walls. The room does not need to be sealed.
